

SUPPLEMENTARY CHALLENGE 150 CONDITIONS

The general conditions for the Championships shall apply to the Challenge150 event except where varied by any of the following conditions.

1. General Conditions

- 1.1. Challenge150 will take place on Sunday 8 December 2019.
- 1.2. Challenge150 may be cancelled should 14 teams or less enter into Challenge150.
 - 1.2.1. In the event of Challenge150 cancellation, entry fees will be refunded. No further refunds will be offered for other incurred costs in relation to Challenge150.
- 1.3. Any Challenge150 entry containing swimmers who are not entered in the Championships, must register the swimmers as Relay Alternate swimmers.

2. Entries

- 2.1. Entries shall be received no later than the 'closing date' i.e. 12 noon on Thursday 21 November 2019, accompanied by the entry fee of £39 per team.
- 2.2. Those teams failing to enter before this 'closing date', but still wishing to compete will be allowed to submit 'late entries' until at least 60 minutes before the start of Session 6 on Saturday 7 December 2019, for which the accompanying entry fee will be twice that of the initial entry fee of £60 per team.

3. Eligibility

- 3.1. Entries shall consist of a mixed team of six members, 3 male and 3 female competitors.
- 3.2. There is no age cap applied on the teams.
- 3.3. Teams may select their own team name (maximum of 20 Characters) subject to the Meet Director's discretion, whose decision on a team name is final.
- 3.4. Competitors may swim for one team only in Challenge150.

4. Event

- 4.1. Mixed 6 x 25 Team Relay.
- 4.2. The teams competing in each race will be selected by a random draw from the total entry. Wherever possible, an even number of teams will race in each race.
- 4.3. Each individual race will have a draw to determine the stroke order for all six legs in that race. The strokes for each of the six legs will be selected from Backstroke, Butterfly, Breaststroke and Freestyle. There is no limit to the number of times each stroke may be drawn.
- 4.4. Team Declaration Forms must be completed and submitted to the Recorders at least 60 minutes before the start Session 7 on Sunday 8 December 2019, in which the team are due to compete.
- 4.5. Competitors must swim in the order declared on the declaration form in each individual races.
- 4.6. Each team selected for the Final, must comprise of the same competitors as in the individual race. The team competitors order cannot be changed from the original declaration form.

5. The Final

5.1. The Final will comprise of 10 teams selected as follows:

- 5.1.1. The winners of each race. Should there be more than 10 race winners the finalist will be selected by random draw from the race winners.
- 5.1.2. Should there be less than 10 race winners, those placed second will be added, should the number exceed 10 then the second placed teams will be selected by draw. If the number of winner and second placed teams do not fill all lanes for the Final the second placed selection process will be repeated for third and subsequent placed teams until all 10 lanes are occupied.

6. Withdrawals

6.1. Withdrawals must be made as follows:

- 6.1.1. Races: no later than 60 minutes before the start of Session 7 on Sunday 8 December 2019.
- 6.1.2. Final: no later than 15 minutes after the Finalists have been announced.

7. Awards

7.1. Cash prizes will be allocated as follows:

- 7.1.1. Races: the winning team of each race will receive £180.
- 7.1.2. The Final: the winning team will receive £600, the second placed team will receive £360 and the third placed team will receive £210.
